



Alumni Scholarship


Blackboard

The ways to access upper floors from the 1st floor





Enter the SK Future Hall through the entrance.

There are three ways to get to upper floors.





If you go straight and turn left, you can find the main elevator behind the wall.

* NOTE It does not operate to the 2nd floor.





① You can find stairs to the 2nd floor.



② If you go up the stairs, there is an exit door to outside.



③ As you turn left and left again, you will see a direct entrance to the 3rd floor.



If you turn right and go straight, you can find stairs and a sub-elevator which operates on all floors.

Public Transportation

Seoul has one of the most convenient and easy to use public transportation systems in the world. Subways, buses, and trains run frequently on time and fares are very affordable. Website: http://m.seoul.go.kr/lang/main/index.do?lang=en

T-money

- T-money is a transportation card system, which is the simple means of paying for public transportation in Seoul. It will save you money when using public transportation.
- · The benefits of using T-money:
 - ① Easy to use and recharge
 - ② Convenient
 - 3 Applicable for subway, buses, and some taxis
 - 4 Free transfer within 30 minutes between buses and subways.
 - ⑤ Purchase at any convenience store for KRW 2,500 (CU, GS25, and 7-Eleven).

Subway

The subway system in Seoul is fast, clean, and convenient.

- ① The basic fare is KRW 1,500 (for T-money card user) with additional fees added depending on the distance you travel.
- ② Most signs are in Korean, English, and Chinese. Different lines are color-coded and all stations have unique assigned number designations.
- ③ Korea University's Campus is directly connected to the metro stations, Korea Univ. Station and Anam Station on Line # 6 (Brown Line).

SIM Card

Need to use your phone in Korea with a prepaid SIM Card? You can easily buy SIM cards at:

- 1 Incheon Airport
- ② Any major convenience store, such as CU, GS25, and 7-Eleven
- ③ Any store of a major phone carrier: KT (olleh), SK Telecom, and LG U+ You must bring identification, preferably passport, in order to buy a SIM card.

Fee

There are different kinds of SIM Card plans and fees for each carrier. (e.g. Data only, Data + Voice Calls & SMS)

Recharge

SIM Cards can be recharged at convenience stores 24/7 at CU, GS25, and 7-Eleven.

- CU: Recharging is done independently. The clerk will give you a receipt with an 11-digit PIN code. You then call 080-013-0114 (free) and follow the instructions on the line. You will receive a confirmation of recharge via SMS.
- GS25 or 7-Eleven: Show your Korean phone number and pay your desired amount of recharge to the clerk
